About the Speakers

Jani Lehtonen is a member of the first violin section in the Helsinki Philharmonic Orchestra and is the concertmaster of the Philharmonic Pops Strings. In 2013 he was appointed concertmaster of the Joensuu City Orchestra. Lehtonen trained at the Sibelius Academy and the Royal Danish Academy of Music. In 2007 he was one of the four prize-winners in the XI Concorso Violino Città di Brescia.



Jani Aarrevaara began his piano studies in Northern Finland and after reaping success in national and Nordic competitions transferred to the University of Music in Würzburg, Germany (in 1995). After receiving his diploma in 1999, Aarrevaara was awarded a special Szymanowski award at the international IBLA Grand Prize piano competition in Italy. In 2013 he was appointed a piano lecturer at the Tampere Conservatoire.
